

Make Me Sweet: Chocotoff



These chocolate toffees are my favourite sweets! I tried to write an easy as possible design so beginning knitters find a small project with some interesting technics. This Chocotoff design is a contribution to the Learn How To Knit area at the Knitting and Stitching Show at Alexandra Palace, London October 11 to 14.

Yarn:

Schulana Merino-Cotton 135 , 50 grams/135 metres. Dark Brown
Anchor Artiste 25 grams. 80 % Viscose/ 20 % metalized polyester. Gold.

Needles: 3mm or other size to obtain gauge.

Gauge 26 sts and 40 rows = 10 x 10 cm.

Finished measurements: 21 x 7 cm.

Other materials needed:

Darning needle, 3 mm crochet hook, sponge, 2 **Stitch Markers**.

Cast on 54 stitches.

*First and every wrong side row: Knit 10 sts, place **SM**, purl 34 sts , place **SM**, knit 10 sts.

Second and every right side row: Knit.

Row17: start knitting the elephant with the gold yarn. Use the intarsia knitting method or decide to add the elephant later in duplicate stitch.

Row 39 to end: Repeat from * for 16 rows. Bind of 10 sts. Knit to end of row, Bind of 10 sts. Graft the remaining 34 sts to the cast on row.

With the crochet hook and the Gold yarn single crochet 2 vertical lines from bottom to top at both sides of the elephant. Fill the sweet with a piece of sponge. Run a piece of yarn through at both sides and pull tight. Weave in all yarn ends.

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
